SUBJECT: RECRUITING MANPOWER
AUTHORITY: OFFICE OF WAR INFORMATION (War Manpower Commission)

Immediate creation of a Man Warpower Commission for Los Angeles is forecast by William K. Hopkins, new WMC Regional Director, just returned from Washington with plans for speeding the recruiting of all unemployed, and of men and women from non-essential industries, for participation in the war production effort.

According to Mr. Hopkins, the new commission will be composed of five local representatives of management and five from labor. The tapping of worker reservoirs will include provision for elderly and partially disabled men and women, but there will be no attempt to draft employables.

Appointment of Hopkins as the First Regional Director thus far named was in recognition of the West Coast area as the number one labor reservoir of the Nation.
